Dear Parents/Carers,

I want to start by thanking you all for adapting to our new routines. You have all responded really well, which has helped us keep our children and our site as safe as possible. You will no doubt have heard (or read) that there have been several schools in Hull and the East Riding with positive cases of the virus, meaning some, or all, children have had to isolate for a 14-day period. So far, we are fortunate that this is not the case for us but we need to continue to be vigilant by abiding by the measures that help prevent transmission.

All adults in school have now been advised to wear face coverings in communal areas, where there is a chance of adults coming in to contact with each other. The guidance suggests that this does not yet need to be the case in outside areas. Can I remind you all to please ensure you keep two metres apart from one another? As you will have heard, cases in this area are on the increase and we need to be even more cautious now.

It is likely that Boris Johnson will make an announcement this evening about further restrictions. If any of these restrictions impact on what we do as a school, further guidance will be sent out.

Safety on Site

Please be aware that our policy is clear that no pets should be brought on to the school site. This is to ensure that we are able to keep all of our community safe. In addition, we ask that bikes and scooters are not ridden on the school site (by either children or parents).

I have attached to this letter some further guidance on ‘what if’, which will assist you in making decisions should your child(ren) or members of your household develop symptoms.
